This application is valid for **one inspection** of piles to be burned over a three-month period. If additional piles are created, or if inspected piles are altered, a new application and inspection is required.

CONDITIONS OF BURNING

1. All burning must be carried out in accordance with the Province's Open Burning Smoke Control Regulation and all relevant City of Enderby bylaws.
2. The holder of a burning permit must notify the Fire Chief (250-838-6950; firechief@cityofenderby.com) prior to each day of burning.
3. Burning may not occur on more than 6 days in a calendar month, for a maximum of 12 days in a calendar year on a single property, in accordance with Provincial regulations.
4. Only well dried and cured products are to be burned. No burning of treated or painted wood products, trade waste, tires, animal carcasses, oil tar, asphalt shingles, battery boxes, plastic materials, or other similar material that may produce heavy or noxious smoke.
5. Every holder of a burning permit shall place a competent person in charge of the fire at all times and shall provide that person with sufficient equipment and water supply to prevent the fire from getting beyond control or causing damage or becoming dangerous. A fire shall be considered out of control when it spreads beyond the boundaries of the parcel of land on which it was started, or threatens to do so, or when it endangers any person, building or property, including those on the same parcel.
6. Despite being allowed to burn by this permit, no person may start a fire if wind and weather are such that to do so is likely to be hazardous, or when inconsistent with a Provincial regulation or enactment, or when the Fire Chief, Chief Administrative Officer, or Emergency Operations Centre Director has implemented a ban or prohibition upon such activities, unless authorized in writing.
7. Burning must not be initiated unless the ventilation index is forecast as:
(a) "good" for the day the open burning is to be started, and
(b) "good" or "fair" on the second day the debris is anticipated to release smoke.

8. All burning must be completely extinguished by dusk unless approved by the Chief Administrative Officer or Fire Chief.
9. The Chief Administrative Officer and/or the Fire Chief may cancel this Burning Permit for failure to comply with its terms and conditions or if hazardous conditions are deemed to exist.
