New Pool Construction to Begin

Construction of the new pool is set to begin in January 2025, with the facility scheduled to open for the start of pool season – May 19, 2026!

As the design process has evolved, a number of improvements to the original design have been made that we are excited to share with you. The biggest improvements include:

- Increased programmable shallow water space and a right-sized lazy river.
- Improved accessibility features.
- Better use of available deck space, including additional shade space and leisure seating.
- Lifeguarding improvements.
- Enhanced change area and washrooms.

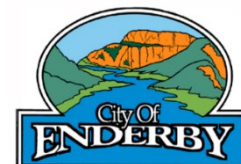
Stay Informed with Alertable

Arena Re-Opening!

The Arena is on track to open the third week in September, at the start of the regular ice season.

A huge thank you to everyone in the community for your support in completing the necessary repairs. The work has included a condition inspection of the chiller, removing and replacing a corroded brine header, cleaning the contaminated brine, and identifying and repairing a brine leak in the floor.

Prevent Wildlife Conflicts

Did you know that you can help prevent wildlife conflicts? Please do not feed wildlife and make sure that your residential garbage is stored in a secure manner and is placed out on the same day as collection in a rigid container with a lid. This will prevent wildlife from being habituated to unnatural food sources and becoming dangerous. A few simple adjustments to how we interact with wildlife can help protect bear, deer, and other animals, as well as keep our neighbourhoods (and our pets!) safe.

- 80-90% of FireSmart homes with non-combustible roofs & 10 metres of clearance will survive a major wildfire?

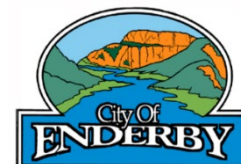
