It's that time of year again! Make sure you claim your Home Owner Grant if you are eligible. Home Owners must apply to the Province for their Home Owner Grant every year. Claim your Home Owner Grant by visiting:

Any grants claimed after July 4 are subject to a 10% penalty.

Property Tax Deferral Program

The Property Tax Deferral Program provides low interest loans to qualified homeowners to pay their annual property taxes. Qualified homeowners must meet one of the following criteria: 55 or older during the year; a surviving spouse of any age; a person with disabilities; or a family with children.

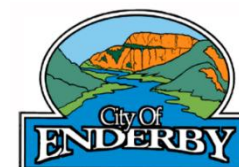

Home Composting & Yard Care

Did you know that the Regional District of North Okanagan offers a 50% rebate, to a maximum amount of \$60, for home composting systems? Eligible products include backyard compost bins, compost tumblers, food waste digesters, Bokashi and vermicomposting systems. Please visit www.rdno.ca/organics for more information, and please make sure that your composter is inaccessible to wildlife!

Don't Feed the Wildlife

Did you know that the City of Enderby is a wildlife interface area? Please ensure that your property does not offer unnatural food sources that attract wildlife; this poses a danger to residents, your pets and wildlife.

Pursuant to the City's Wildlife Attractant Bylaw, please ensure that you:

- Store your garbage indoors or otherwise in durable, rigid receptacles that are fitted with covers that are inaccessible to wildlife; and
- Do not place your garbage at the curbside earlier than 4:00 am on the day of collection.

Water Wisely

Watering conservation is in effect from May 1 until October 1 every year. This helps to decrease over-watering and conserve water for drinking and maintaining reserves for firefighting.

Sprinkling is permitted between the hours of 6:00 am and 9:00 am and 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm. Properties with even numbered civic addresses may water on even numbered days. Properties with odd numbered civic addresses may water on odd numbered days. Properties with automatic sprinkling systems may water between the hours of 12:00 am and 6:00 am on their assigned watering days provided that sprinkling does not exceed 6 hours in any 24 hour period.

Remember, just because it is your day to water, that does not mean that you must water. Check first and only water if it's needed.

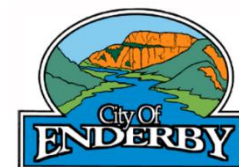
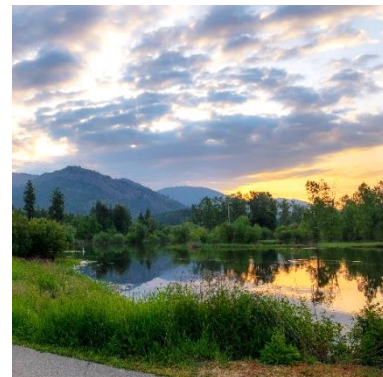
VISION, MISSION, AND VALUES
