### RadonAware Community Testing

The City of Enderby is partnering with the BC Lung Foundation to provide free radon test kits to residents of Enderby and Area F this fall.

Radon is a colourless, ordourless gas that can accumulate in homes and workplaces, and can lead to adverse health impacts with prolonged exposure.

Below are 5 simple steps you can take to significantly reduce the risk of wildfire in the community and around your home or property:

- 1. Remove all combustible material (twigs, dry grass, leaves) within 10 m of your home.
- 2. Remove leaves, tree needles, branches and other debris from your roof and gutters.
- 3. Do not use bark or pine needle mulch around your home as these materials are highly flammable.
- 4. Plant fire-resistant landscaping around your home, such as leafy plants. Needled trees and shrubs are highly flammable.
- 5. Avoid storing items such as firewood piles, construction materials, and patio furniture against or near to your house.

#### **Prevent Wildlife Conflicts**

Did you know that you can help prevent wildlife conflicts? Please do not feed wildlife and make sure that your residential garbage is stored in a secure manner and is placed out on the same day as collection in a rigid container with a lid. This will prevent wildlife from being habituated to unnatural food sources and becoming dangerous. A few simple adjustments to how we interact with wildlife can help protect bear, deer, and other animals, as well as keep our neighbourhoods (and our pets!) safe.

## Grab-and-go Kits


Are you prepared for an emergency? A grab-and-go kit is a small emergency kit that's easy to take with you, in case you need to leave right away.

Here is a list of some items to include in your grab-and-go kit:

- Non-perishable food and water
- Phone charger and battery bank
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries
- Small first aid kit and personal medications
- Personal toiletries and items such as an extra pair of glasses
- Copy of your emergency plan
- Copies of important documents, such as insurance papers and ID
- Cash in small bills
- Seasonal clothing & an emergency blanket
